



Annex 1 Safety regulations and basic agreements on board

- Lifejackets:
 - Arruno Exploration provides the participant with a valid self-inflating life jacket equipped with:
 - 150N buoyancy
 - Crotch straps
 - MOB torch (Man Over Board)
 - Harness
 - Lifeline
 - The life jacket is always worn while sailing from the moment the participant emerges from the ship's cabin.
 - If the participant moves on deck from the cockpit, the participant makes sure they are clipped in.
 - When the vessel is sailing between sunset and sunrise, the participant shall ensure that they carry the following MOB devices with him:
 - AIS MOB Device
 - Possible PLB (not provided by Arruno Exploration)
- Cooking:
 - Everyone cooperates on board to complete daily tasks.
 - Handling boiling/hot water is always done with protective gloves to avoid burns.
 - Boiling liquids on the fire and during processing are handled sensibly.
 - The participant is aware that the vessel can make unexpected movements while sailing.
 - It is the participant's responsibility that after cooking, they make sure the gas is shut off with the tap inside by the gas fire.
 - Great care is required when handling sharp equipment such as knives.
- Installation of safety equipment
 - Each participant will be aware of the locations of the safety equipment on departure.
 - Each participant attentively follows the safety tour after embarkation.
- Manoeuvring:
 - With every manoeuvre of the vessel, each participant is aware to do the operations with due caution to avoid personal injury:
 - When jibbing, watch out for the boom blowing over
 - Operations on the winches should be done in such a way that there is no risk of pinched fingers
 - In case of mooring manoeuvres, the tasks are passed in advance. The participant is aware that the vessel weighs nearly 20 tonnes as a function of handling ropes.
 - The participant exactly follows the instructions given by the captain.
- Escape and ventilation hatches:
 - The participant will check with you on each departure that all hatches are closed. When the ship is not docked, hatches are only opened with the captain's approval.
- Alcohol:
 - Alcohol may be consumed only when the ship is docked to a fixed object or with exception if the captain approves.
- Orders, instructions from the captain:
 - While sailing, the captain's decisions are not debated or disregarded.
